Evelyn Thomas, the famous Chicago singer who helped shape the sound of HI-NRG Disco with her 1984 smash hit '[High Energy](#)', will release a new EP featuring two brand new tracks this **September** through One Media, together with an extended version of the classic hit 'High Energy', which was originally mixed and recorded by respected producer and One Media collaborator, Ian Levine.



The two new tracks, 'Work That Thang' and 'Take a Chance and Dance', were recorded by Evelyn, after being persuaded by us to come out of retirement by Michael Infante, following the tragic loss of her husband last year.

The results are two upbeat, funky tunes that are destined to light up the dance floor together with a cracking *number 1* original remix of her '80s hit.

'Work That Thang' rips along at 120+bpm. It's pegged down by a trancey, minimal 2-step drum loop with a catchy staccato keyboard riff that allows Evelyn the space to tear it up with her mesmerising vocals, which have aged to her (our!) advantage: there's a lovely edge to that soul voice. The full-length version is a treat. Evelyn may be 69 years old but she still has the chops.

"One Media IP Group's Michael Infante joins Katie to talk about its 13% jump in half-year revenue and future strategy. 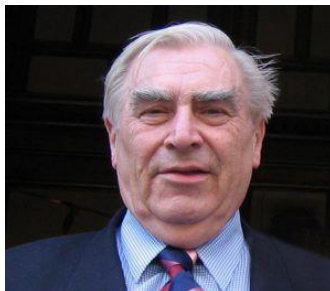

It’s been several years since the passing of Alan Peters and as owners of his great catalogue (AJP Records) we have paid tribute to him by the creation of the Alan Peters website <http://alanpetersorchestra.co.uk>

Alan Peters was an outstanding violinist who started life playing in the military and went on to play with many of the leading London Orchestras. He was lead violinist with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, a member of the London Philharmonic Orchestra and the Philharmonia Orchestra and was leader of the Royal Opera House, (Covent Garden) Ballet Orchestra. As an independent record producer Alan recorded hundreds of music tracks both classical and easy listening and was fondly named "The Duke of Barnes" after his recording studio there. After Alan retired from performing, he acted as Producer alongside of our Michael Infante as Executive Producer for the world’s largest set of recordings with one Orchestra (The Royal Philharmonic Orchestra), between 1992 and 1997, recording over 150 albums at CTS Wembley, many receiving critical acclaim. Alan worked with countless legends of the music industry including Shirley Bassey, Tom Jones, Paul McCartney, Dionne Warwick and many, many more.
